**LAMP WITH A LEGACY** In 1932, British automotive engineer George Carwardine patented an innovative lamp whose neck could swivel in a range of directions. Since then, Carwardine's design has become the definitive prototype for the flexible table lamps that adorn dorm room and office desks worldwide. This year, U.K. lighting emporium Anglepoise is exporting its updated version, the Original 1227, across the pond. Sold exclusively at Provide in Vancouver, the lamp features aluminum arms and a weighted base, modern additions like energy-saving bulbs, and sleek colours ranging from chrome to cream. Like a true classic, the Original only gets better with age. *From \$340, Provide* ■
